


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# **International Speakers**



### John S. Bradley, MD

Dr. Bradley is a Distinguished Professor in the Department of Pediatrics, Division of Infectious Diseases at the University of California San Diego, School of Medicine. He is also the Medical Director for Infectious Diseases at Rady Children's Hospital in San Diego, California.

His research involves therapeutics for serious infections using pharmacokinetic/pharmacodynamic modeling, with NICHD support to study beta-lactam antibiotics in pediatric septic shock.
